-**“BYOB Wine and Cheese and Shoot the Breeze.”** A get-together at the clubhouse on a Friday evening a couple of times a year for discussion and mingling. This could be combined with the next item.

-An annual meeting in the **spring welcoming all new residents of Sandy Point** i.e. Wine and Cheese etc.
